**subsequently experience elevated levels of suicidal behaviors, depression, substance abuse, anxiety and other mental problems.** The higher rates of mental disorders cannot be explained by any pre-pregnancy differences in mental health, according to the study.

The findings surprised even pro-abortion researchers who confirmed that the data persistently pointed toward the politically unwelcome conclusion that abortion does cause mental health problems. Pro-choice researcher Professor David M. Fergusson, said that it would be "scientifically irresponsible" to suppress the findings simply because it touched on an explosive political issue.

Yet we still see misguided parents bringing their teenage daughters to Planned Parenthood for abortions because pregnancy would "ruin their summer vacation and future social life". With stupid parents like this, what chance do the girls have of a decent life??
