- 1. \$250 Discount Package** - additional charge for more sedation - expect delays - no support person allowed - cash only
- 2. \$350 Economy Package** - most popular - includes beverages, snacks and choice of pain relievers
- 3. \$550 Do-it-yourself-option** - take a pill today then abort in the comfort of your own home within three days - full instructions
- 4. \$650 Family Package** - select one support person whom the staff will train
- 5. \$1000 Full Emotional Support Package** - two hours of counseling for self and support person - self help books furnished
- 6. \$3000 Deluxe Spa Treatment** - includes massage, Jacuzzi, facial, feather pillow bed, room service
- 7. \$5000 Spiritual Journey** - spiritual healer and guide helps arrange religious ceremony - choice of themes including Native American, Eastern Philosophy, pagan ritual - optional Friday night mountain retreat provides ritual cleansing for the "surgical procedure when she is ready for a separation of

Carron Coffee House Association Board held it's Quarterly meeting on January 24, 2007.

conflict with the fish fries. All drivers and volunteers are welcome to attend, while showing support of the Knights of Columbus for a highly respected program, which bi-weekly offers entertainment, a meal, then closing with a special Mass.

The annual Picnic will be held September 15, 2007. 78 volunteers have lent their time and support to Coffee House for a total of 458 man hours of service.

There is a weekly average attendance at the Coffee House of 44 clients. This compares to 51.5 clients at its peak in 2000. However, this 44-client average is a larger selection of clientele since the Knights fully took over sponsorship in 2004. Because Council 10122 at Queen of Peace parish is now sponsoring clients from the Eastern Metropolitan side, while these numbers are not included in Coffee House's average. Last year they averaged 15 to 21 additional clients.

For the Second Half of 2006, the Coffee House Association received \$1,470.47 in donations while spending \$7,266.53 leaving an account balance of \$22,890.80. The biggest portion of the Coffee House funding comes from the Tootsie Roll's, Mentally Challenged Drive held by the Knights of Columbus.
