### **A CATHOLIC ABOMINATION?**

In the recent Supreme Court decision affirming the Partial Birth Abortion Ban Act, the five Justices approving the ban are all supposedly Roman Catholic. That seems to be good news for the Church, but when they describe the ruling it is written so narrowly that it reassures the abortion industry that **so long as they don't pull the poor little human out of the womb beyond the navel before killing it, no crime has been committed!**

The Court even reassures those sloppy Partial Birth Abortionists that **"If a living fetus is delivered past the critical point by accident or inadvertence, the Act is inapplicable.....no crime has occurred."**

They even further reassure the killers that they are free to do their grizzly late term business by other means: **"The Act excludes most D&Es (Dilation and Evacuations) in which the fetus is removed in pieces, not intact."**
